- 1. Fairmont Scottsdale Princess** **Nov 16 - Jan 2**
This annual event is something out of a storybook - featuring a real ice-skating rink, slippery slide, and a classic carousel. Decorated inside and outside, it is filled with treats for the entire family.
- 2. Zoolights at the Phoenix Zoo** **Nov 24 - Jan 15**
Animal displays, trees and walkways throughout the park are illuminated and synchronized with holiday tunes.
- 3. World of Illumination** **Nov 17 - Jan 2**
This event claims to be the largest animated light show in the world. The 25-minute drive-through event features two million lights synchronized to holiday music. In Glendale or Tempe Diablo Stadium.
- 4. Glendale Glitters** **Nov 29 - Jan 11**
This free family-friendly activity offers a chance to view two million lights decorating the historic downtown Glendale area.
- 5. McCormick Stillman Railroad Park** **Nov 29 - Jan 2**
This Park offers a mini steam train ride around its illuminated "villages" and scenes. Best of all, Santa is waiting for kids in a historic train car through Dec. 23 for photos.
- 6. Las Noches de las Luminarias** **Dec 3 - Dec 31**
A southwestern holiday tradition at the Desert Botanical Garden. Each evening features 8,000 hand lit luminarias, and live entertainment. This year the event is even brighter with the inclusion of Chihuly in the Desert.
- 7. Holiday Lights at Salt River Fields** **Nov 19 - Jan 1**
This drive-through experience features five million lights across 1.2 miles. Enjoy lights that dance to music broadcast to a designated FM station.
- 8. Scottsdazzle** **Nov 27 - Dec 31**
Celebrate the season in Old Town Scottsdale. Enjoy free events including culinary demonstrations, family activities plus public art installations. The event kicks off with a sing-a-long & Tree Lighting Ceremony on Saturday, Nov. 27 at 7 pm.
